

SCOPE OF SERVICES

1. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

RGM's Supply Chain department is seeking for a transport company to provide with container transport services for their purchased goods and (raw) materials.

2. SCOPE OF SERVICES

2.1. Specification of work

Transport of Hazmat and Non Hazmat Containers (standard 20 foot & 40 foot containers)

2.2. Responsible department

Supply Chain department, Logistics department

2.3. Location

- Container Transport from Paramaribo to Rosebel Gold Mines site and vice versa.
- Various cargo from JAP Airport to RGM site.

2.4. Start date & period of implementation

TBD

2.5. Facilities to be provided by RGM

RGM will assist in the offloading of cargo at the Warehouse at RGM site, using RGM equipment and personnel.

2.6. Pricing Schedule

The pricing will have to be done as per Bill of Quantity provided an hourly rate in United States dollars (USD) that is fixed for at least one (1) year.

The contractor must provide with a breakdown per rate. (e.g. fuel, cargo insurance, etc)

3. REQUIREMENTS

3.1. Personnel to be provided by the Contractor

The contractor has to arrange for own drivers and co-drivers.

3.2. Facilities to be provided by the Contractor

The contractor will make use of own equipment to perform the work.

All cost for maintenance, parts and replacement of equipment are fully on the account of the contractor. The contractor is also responsible to arrange for own fuel for any equipment utilized during the performance of this service.

All equipment and/or cargo damages that occur during these transport services are fully on account of the contractor.

4. REFERENCE DOCUMENTS

RGM Policies:

In addition to the services outlined in the specification, the Contractor shall comply with all policies and codes of practice, which can be found in the following locations;

HR requirements:

- Police clearance for all contractor's working on site/ RGM projects.
- Medical screening from HCCO – Human Capital Care Outsourcing
- Proof of SOR insurance for all contractors working on site
- Proof of Liability insurance for involved contractor employees and equipment

Health & Safety requirements:

- General induction should be completed for all contractor employees that will be utilized for this specific service.
- All mobile equipment; light vehicles and operators that will be utilized for this specific service must comply with RGM Mobile Equipment standard.
- All mobile equipment to be used for this service will need to undergo an RGM equipment inspection first.
- Contractors should adhere to the IAMGOLD golden rules and Core Safety Values.
